Minutes:

1. Sara McLaughlin was not in attendance but she had reported to Michael that the most recent MDL testing was fine.
2. The group reviewed the results of the mold testing done by Universal Environmental Consultants. The inspection was thorough. Paint samples were taken. They also tested for harmful asbestos and fiberglass. There were several common types of mold detected in the building however they are not hazardous. The conclusion of the report states: *Testing for airborne mold indicates normal background levels inside the occupied areas of the school.*
3. The committee still has questions about the odor that comes and goes at the end of the hallway, near the Media Center.
4. The members of HSAC will share the mold testing results at our next staff meeting. We'll also try to recruit new members to serve on our committee.
5. We also inquired about the schedule for changing the filters. Some of them are accumulating dust. MK said he thought they were changed quarterly. He will ask Tom Franks about the specific schedule.
6. On a positive note, the teachers remarked that the classrooms have been cleaned well this fall. Computers have been dusted. The bathrooms also look great. Kudos to Francis, Gary, and Tom!
