

## **HSAC Minutes-4/8/15**

Michael Kascak confirmed that the next meeting will be May 23 @ 6:15 pm. Also, there are no changes in the levels of compounds that are monitored by Lord Associates. Mr. Kascak spoke briefly about the big meeting with Lord Associates and what was discussed in order to inform Mr. Kirschner, who was not present at several of the last meetings.

Mr. Kascak explained about the grievance procedure, having to do with the cleanliness and safety of the building that is now at level II and will be resolved at level II.

Mr. Kascak informed that Cricket Field is now “off the table” for the Hillside project. Hillside is going to be an elementary school for 4-5 years and a “swing space” for up to 10 years. The building needs regular custodial support for this to occur. Mr Kirschner expressed a fiduciary responsibility pertaining to building the new school and to build it at a cost-efficient site that doesn’t involve moving populations all over the town during and after the construction.

Mr.. Kascak and Mrs. Greiff discussed melding of Crisis team and HSAC once there are crisis guidelines set for the town. We will continue to practice the Fire, Headcount, Shelter in-Place, as well as practice an Evacuation drill this spring.
